The idea, as discussed in the video presentation, is to learn to more honestly and accurately distinguish between those things that we teach by just passing on beliefs and those which we teach by giving the reasons for what we hold—i.e. by giving knowledge. Beliefs, or better opinions, are fine and necessary, but we should always recognize them for what they are.
